

Bible Reading Team

What's involved?

Reading one of the Bible readings in Sunday morning and evening services.

What kind of person is needed?

People with a clear voice, who are willing to look at the reading in advance, and ensure that they are confident to read it well.

What's the commitment?

There are separate teams for the morning and evening services. Some people are on both teams, but most are either on the morning or evening team. Members of the morning team are on duty about once every six weeks, in the evening once a month is average. Bible readers are expected to be at church 20 minutes before the start of the service to join in praying for the service.

What training is available?

Prior to the first time you read in a service, it can be arranged for you to practice reading in church, to get used to the sound system and the best pace for reading.
