25th December (9am)

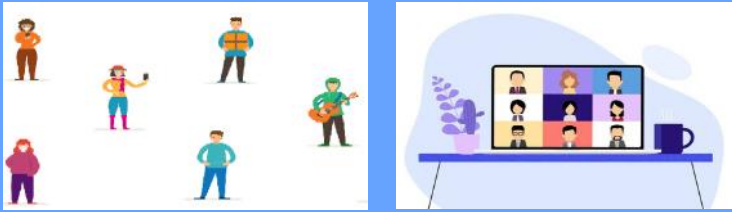
We are hoping to video these and make them available online later in the day. To book into these services please ring the office on the Thursday morning preceding the service.
