Thanks

At the start of this New year we give thanks for sending all clients to us that need your love at the moment.

Thanks too for sustaining us through a stressful few months.

Help all of us to manage our diaries without stress through this time of cancellations due to COVID.

Thanks too for the many people who support us financially, practically and through prayer.

Common issues facing our clients

- Lots of cancelled visits due to illness – COVID particularly
- Heating costs
- Inconsistent benefits claims.
- Several very close to completing their DROs – pray this will go through soon so they can be debt free.

Telford Centre

- **New Debt coach** - Pray for Lizzie who has started visiting clients this week. Help her to manage the complex needs of the clients and to understand the CAP system.
- **Client Visits** – Marcelle and I are struggling to manage the client visits in our diaries at the moment as a large number have cancelled due to illness and COVID isolation. Help us not to get stressed about this and to work through the backlog this creates.
- **Volunteers** – Pray for health of our volunteers – to keep them strong and infection free. Pray that the DBS for our new volunteers comes through quickly.
- **Partnership** – Pray for the **partnership meeting on 25th January**. Help us to work through the various agenda items with God always as our focus. Give us wisdom. Continue to pray for the smooth change over of our bank account from Mercian Trust to All Saints and that donors who haven't yet switched will do so soon.

Other Things

- **Talks in Churches – Shifnal Methodist on 6th Feb** – pray that God will speak to this congregation and they will want to become involved in some way.
Pray too for new opportunities to speak in churches in Telford.
- **New CAP services** – we continue to pray that churches around Telford will be encouraged to start a new CAP service in Telford to work alongside the debt centre such as a **Life Skills group or Job club**. Several churches are looking at this possibility but need the right people to come forward to train and manage them. Pray that God will send the right people and that if it is God's will then everything will fall into place. We particularly pray for the House of Prayer who really want to move forward in this ministry. Give the church leaders guidance we pray.
- **Money Course** – pray for new opportunities to run the money course around the town.
- **Fundraising** – Pray for the **Pancake Party** Fundraising idea – that individuals and cafes will help to raise funds for the debt centre by selling pancakes (Flyer attached to this email). Also that we will be able to run other events. Pray for grant opportunities particularly to help clients with bankruptcy and DRO fees.

Strength & Encouragement

Pray that God will give us strength and encouragement to follow through the work he has called us to do with fresh energy and enthusiasm at the start of this New Year.
